- 2.) AG2 Loren Cope; Was embarked Salisbury Sound AV-13 with Fleet Air Wing One Staff in late 1951-early 1952 at Buckner Bay when I was ship's company; one of my roommates in the four-to-a-room barracks at Lakehurst; To Point Mugu from B School; From Ohio near the end of PA Turnpike; was best man at our wedding in North Hollywood in Mar.1953.
 - 3.) AG2 Gordo Welch. Later was AG Detailer.
- 4.) AG1 Frank Suter; Station keeper from NAS Dallas on TAD to B School; liked to go to Eisenhauer's (sic) Musical Bar to listen to the Texas Hymns and drink beer.
- 5.) AG1 Pappy Boynton; Later was commissioned in army Signal Corps I believe.
- 6.) AG1 Al Graham; US Coast Guard; Note the shield on the right arm; TAD to B School from Rescue Coordination Center which was located on Sansome Street in San Francisco at the time; believe he left Coast Guard and went to college in Mid-Fifties; last saw him in Redondo Beach or Hermosa Beach about 1955.
 - 7.) AG1 Harry Vinicombe; Roommate at B School; Died 1991
 - 8.) AG1 Joe Sycuro; Was in my A School class also.
 - 9.) AG1 Gustafson; Reported to class as AG2 from Salisbury Sound; Transferred to PG school after B School.
 - 10.) AG1 Voorheis; Was at Suitland in Mid-fifties.

- 11.) SSgt Rocke; USMC; Believe I might have met him at MCAS Opalocka, FL about 1958. No further contact; played piano by ear.
- 12.) AG2 Hunter; Station keeper TAD to B School from NAS Oakland when it was along Doolittle Drive.
- 13.) AG1 Dick Greene; Believe he was commissioned a 1100 line officer in Mid-Fifties; Talked to him in a parking lot in the Mission Valley of San Diego about 1968, was skipper of a minesweeper at the time.
